<u>Soul Care</u>, by Jason Perkins- Are you overwhelmed by the noise, busyness, and pace of your life? Join Jason Perkins for this six-part series on Soul Care and learn to tend to the garden of your inner life. Discover what it means to apprentice under the Master, Jesus — not just by believing His teachings, but by living the way He lived. As you adopt His rhythms of rest and relationship and practise His habits of silence, solitude, Sabbath, and simplicity, your soul will begin to thrive and bear fruit.

Follow: Life-Giving Habits, by Jo Strohfeldt- In the person of Jesus, God calls all people not to simply know about Him, but to follow Him with all that we are. Following Jesus daily is more like a habit than it is a moment. Habits are things we do often and regularly, without consciously thinking we have to do them. This 6-week course will explore life-giving habits to establish us in the new life that Jesus gives.

<u>Holy Habits</u>, by Derwin Gray- When God calls us to himself, he sets us apart—he makes us holy. But what does it mean to be holy? What habits define God's people, no matter where they are on earth or which denomination they are a part of? In this four-session series, pastor Derwin Gray explores four foundational behaviors of Christians. God calls us to a new way of living, one formed by rhythms of holiness.

<u>The Ruthless Elimination of Hurry</u>, by John Mark Comer- We are all busy. Some of us can't remember the last time we rested or even had free time. Our busyness can feel productive but it is a toxic distraction, sapping our spiritual, physical, and emotional vitality. It may seem like we have no choice but to live at a frantic pace, but God has a better path for us.

<u>10 Day Challenge - Christian Faith</u>, by Dave Mann- The 10 Day Challenge series is a hopeful look into the Christian faith. These videos are highly practical and have been designed to be used by individuals, two friends in a cafe, or within groups to discuss together these foundational areas of Christian faith: Addressing The Bible, Prayer, Church, Faith, Holiness, Love, Mission, Success, and Keeping it real.
