Some suggested Right Now Videos to view in response to this week's message:

Easter, by J.D. Greear-The resurrection is the most important moment in history, but it is more than an event we remember on Easter Sunday. These videos take a deeper look at Jesus's life, death, and resurrection in the Gospel of Matthew, revealing the ways we should see ourselves in the story. Jesus died for us so that he could be alive in us today. Easter changes everything.

The Book of Galatians, by Kyle Idleman-If someone asked you to explain the gospel, what would you say? What is the good news of the Christian faith? Writing to the Galatians, Paul made it clear how easily we can be tempted to turn toward fraudulent gospels, especially those that teach we can earn God's love through our works. Though they may have the appearance of truth, they are lifeless and leave us empty in the end. Kyle shows that true freedom is found in surrender, not self-dependence. Because our gospel is not one based on our works, but faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ

I Believe in Easter- How did Easter, a word with origins in pagan tradition, come to embody the oldest and most important festival in Christianity? Discover the origins of Easter in this thoroughly researched and emotionally charged documentary. The history of Easter is traced to ancient Egypt where the story finds its roots in the deliverance of the Israelites from slavery. The program features powerfully dramatized scenes from the gospels along with insightful documentary footage shot in the Holy Land and at the Vatican, plus insightful commentary from church scholars and historians. I Believe in Easter will give you new insights into the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ—the most important event in human history.
