**Some suggested Right Now Videos** to view in response to this week's message:

**Apart From Me You Can Do Nothing**, by Pete Briscoe- There is a temptation in leadership to lean into the talents and gifts God has given us in order to exercise biblical leadership. The pitfall is that we can begin to lead with God's gifts, but end up relying on our own strength. Digging deep into John 15:4-5, Pete Briscoe, Senior Pastor of Bent Tree Bible Fellowship, shares his personal struggles and reminds us that we can do nothing of eternal significance apart from Jesus Christ.

**Keeping Place**, by Jen Pollock Michel- Home. There's nowhere quite like it. It's a safe place, a place of belonging, the place we feel secure. And if we're honest, at our core we all long for home. Our longing might be sprinkled with nostalgia or laced with pain, but regardless, we all feel the ache of homesickness in our hearts. God is a homemaker. He created the earth for us to live in and He's preparing a place for us to spend eternity with Him. Jesus came, died, and rose again so we could become part of His family—a family with the inheritance of eternity. Join in this journey through Scripture to uncover the meaning of home.

**Glory Days**, Max Lucado- Life has a way of taking the life out of us. Often we go through situations where the challenge seems so much greater than our strength. During such times, we can find hope and inspiration from the story of Joshua. God has called Joshua to take over from Moses and lead the Israelites into a paradigm shift from wilderness wandering to promise-believing. In Canaan, they would not fight for victory but fight from victory. God had a Promised Land in store for them, but they had to grasp that reality, change their mindsets, and take action to receive it. The same is true for us today. God is telling us that our best days - our "glory days"- are still ahead of us.
