God is a Worker, Bill Peel- Bill Peel is the best-selling author of six books and the Director of the Faith and Work Center at LeTourneau University. Bill talks about how God is a worker and we were created and called to imitate Him.

Core Values & Decisions, by Jennifer Degler- The pleasure and joy we feel in our work or ministry often comes down to how that labor reflects our core values. Psychologist Jennifer Degler discusses the individual values that drive each of us, and tells us how to embrace our values for the good of our decisions.

The Life We Long to Live, by Tom Nelson- It is easy for us to look at our work as a necessity that we engage because we need money to live, and even regard our time at work as an encumbrance to time that could be spent in ministry. Tom Nelson argues, however, that our work matters to God and provides a great opportunity to live the Greatest Commandment. In this session, Tom shares insights drawn from his book "Work Matters."

Laboring For a God Who Fights For Us- What can the Old Testament teach us about life in Christ? In this session from the 2014 The Gospel Coalition Women's Conference, author and pastor Tim Keller explains how the events in Nehemiah 3 and 4 point to the priesthood of believers and power of the Holy Spirit.
