Redwood Faith, by Nate Ruch- God wants to grow us in our faith. However, too many Christians are stuck, thinking and acting the same ways year after year. Instead of rising up like a grand redwood tree to be a witness to God's love and life, they bounce around in mediocrity of the bushes. Redwood Faith aims to change this pattern by introducing key elements that will grow you in your relationship with Christ. The primary element is that of getting connected with others who are committed to the same faith journey. In our modern individualistic society where people feel isolated and alone, while at the same time having far too many surface relationships, we must rethink how our connections, or the lack of them, impact our faith. When we do, we find ourselves growing in Christ in ways that we don't expect.

Forensic Faith, by J Warner Wallace- Why Do You Believe? Many people are Christians in the same way they're a Missourian or an American. They were born and raised in the church yet are unable to answer any pressing questions people might ask about Christianity. Today's culture is increasingly skeptical so we must have answers that stand up to aggressive challenges. In this video, Cold-Case Detective J. Warner Wallace discusses the importance of "testing" the truths of Christianity, asking why people say they're Christians, and understanding the difference between experience and evidence when explaining what we base our belief on.

Water-Walking Faith, by Jason Mendis-God's dream for your life isn't in the boat. It's on the waves. And He is calling you to step out. In this inspiring six-part series, Jason Mendis walks us out onto the water and into the astonishing encounter between Peter and Jesus in which Peter responds to the call to step out of the boat and into the unknown. The details hidden within this extraordinary story show us what it could look like to live a life of water-walking faith, confident in God's direction and provision.
