Engaged & Transformed: Now You Are The Body Of Christ, by Chris Brown- What would happen if our team lived in the reality that each member is a unique reflection of Christ? When the members of our team are not equipped and empowered to live out their unique reflection of Christ in their unique reflection of Christ in their life and ministry, then our Christian schools operate from a position of disability. This thought-provoking devotional video challenges us to examine our leadership, our perspectives and our practice when it comes to embracing the reality that we are the Body of Christ.

The Birth of the Church, by Joe Boyd- In this five-part devotional series, Joe Boyd looks at the life of the early church as seen in Acts Chapter 2. This series explores what it looks like to build a kingdom community or a "new community". What does it mean to be the church? What does it mean to be a family? Joe Boyd suggest five statements about the early church and five questions to consider how to apply these learnings in our churches and small groups.

God's Blueprint for the Local Body, by D.A. Horton- In Acts 2:42-47 God provides us with a snapshot of what life during the First Century Church looked like. Arguably, the mission of the Church is described in great detail. In this session from the 2015 RightNow Conference, D.A. Horton works through this passage in order to find transcendent principles we can apply in our context today.
