Ministry Outside the Walls, by Dhati Lewis- Dhati Lewis, the Senior Pastor at Blueprint Church in Atlanta, Georgia, encourages his congregation to live their lives on mission in their jobs and with their families. In this training, he discusses how his church works to build up all of its members and how he personally applies these principles in his own family.

Mission Drift, by Peter Greer- All faith-based organizations—from non-profits, to churches, to educational institutions, even Christian-owned businesses—will, without careful attention, inevitably drift away from their founding purpose and mission. In this 6-part course based on his book, "Mission Drift," Peter Greer helps you recognize the well-worn path of mission drift, and choose instead to remain mission true.
