What Is a Christian?, by Francis Chan- Ask any group what it means to be a Christian, and we will hear different answers. But what unifies us? What are the basic characteristics of our faith that every Christian affirms? In this series, Francis Chan will lead us in an exploration of key concepts common to all Christians through the centuries. No matter what divides us, we are united by these truths about the God we worship & our relationship with him.

Truth and Love, by Marquise Cox- Have you ever had to choose between truth and love? Sometimes, the truth can feel harsh and unloving, but can we really love someone without telling them the truth? It isn't unusual to wrestle with balancing what is right with what we feel, but what if we didn't have to choose between truth and love? Join pastor Marquise Cox in this four-session series as he shows us how to speak the truth in love, wrestle with doubts, talk about Jesus with people who disagree with us, and share our faith. You don't have to choose between being loving or truthful—in Christ, we can do both.

Talking with Your Kids about Jesus, by Natasha Crain- Homes where deep and meaningful faith conversations happen regularly aren't the product of lucky parents. They're the product of intentional parents who believe nothing is more important than raising kids to know and love Jesus. In this six-session series, author Natasha Crain offers parents tools and encouragement for creating low-grade, consistent efforts to clarify who Jesus is, why he matters, and how kids can live impacted by their faith in him.

How to Become a Christian, by Grant Agler- Simple answers to complex questions. Faith in Jesus is simpler than you might think. In this course, we cut through the religious jargon and share just the important fundamentals found in the New Testament. You will discover how to become a Christian as well as what it means to "follow Jesus" in your day-to-day life. We believe that the content in this course can and will lead you to a restored relationship with God himself. Whoever finds God, finds life.
