The Worship Dilemma, by Aaron Short & Jeremy Ellis- In this series, we tackle the ongoing dilemma of who or what we worship in our lives and how what we worship can have the biggest impact in influencing our decisions and direction in life.

Worship in the Word- For years, Christian artists Shane & Shane have made Colossians 3:16 their mission: “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.” Now that they’ve been raising kids of their own, it’s become their greatest desire for their children to know God’s Word & have a vibrant, intimate relationship with Jesus—and they want to help make that a reality for your kids as well

Understanding Worship, by Tom Kraeuter- Why is it that the vast majority of regular attenders of Christian churches don’t know what worship is? And just as importantly, how can we change that? Understanding Worship can be a big part of the answer. Tom Kraeuter has taught about worship for decades. His vast background—ministering in almost 500 churches of nearly every size, in practically every U.S. state and every major Protestant denomination—he now brings all that background into your living room or Sunday School class to help you more fully understand worship from a truly biblical perspective. Your thinking will change—perhaps dramatically—but even more importantly, your heart will be changed, too.
