Sacrifice and Atonement in the Bible, by Tim Mackie- The Bible is so lengthy that it can be difficult to see how everything connects. The theme of sacrifice and atonement, for example, shows up in Israel's ritual sacrifices and when Jesus died on the Cross. In this post, The Bible Project looks at how the theme of sacrifice and atonement weaves through the pages of Scripture.

In Light of Eternity, by Francis Chan- Caution: For their twentieth wedding anniversary, Francis and Lisa Chan traveled to East Africa to visit a ministry committed to helping young women out of the sex industry and providing for orphans and children in need. At the time, they were writing a book on marriage, later published as, You and Me Forever. After experiencing the work of the ministry in Africa, they decided to self-publish the book as a way of maximizing the book's earning potential and devote the proceeds to the ministry. Using their story, this film offers a powerful glimpse into the light God is shining in the dark places of Africa by telling the tales of transformed lives as well as those who devoted their resources toward the service of others. But this film is also an invitation to consider what God has given to us that we can extend to those in need for the sake of introducing them to their greatest need—a relationship with Jesus Christ.
