The Prodigal Son

Setting
in which
parable told
to Tax collectors
and sinners, Pharisees
and teachers of religious law

Summary of Parable

2 sons - younger
took inheritance early
and wasted it, Took job
Feeding pigs, realized father's servant
lived better than he was. Went
home to repent and asked to be
hired as a servant. Father was
watching and ran to greet son when
spotted younger son. Father held
celebration for return of younger
son. *Older son's perspective to
come later.

By asking
for inheritance
early, younger son
in that culture was saying
Give me your stuff, your as
good as dead to me to his
dad

Disturbing Grace #1: The Father's bent to give even
when He's being betrayed,

Father
Ran to his son ← (God) was looking
for His son!

Disturbing Grace #2: One Heavenly Father is in
relentless pursuit of his children
Younger son restored once he turned back to the
Father
